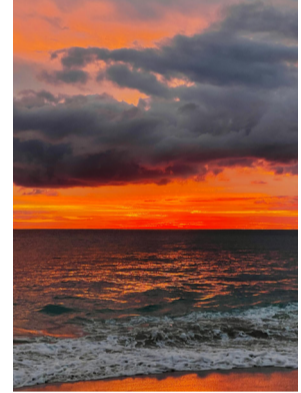


Being at the right place at the right time is an accurate meld between time and space that happens remarkably frequently at this destination.

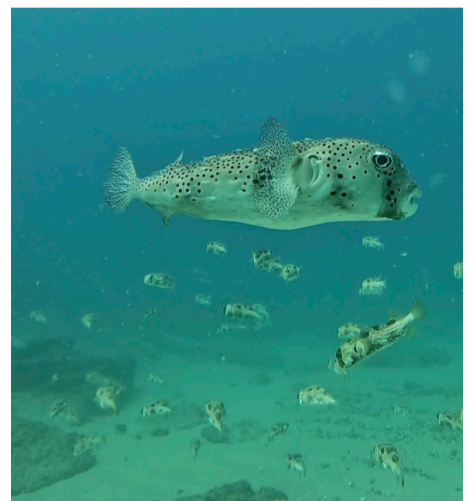


Through the vast repertoire of descriptions found regarding Cabo Pulmo, a persistent common factor is true about this immaculate destination, the underwater exploration grants an incomparable experience on this site considered an aquatic gem.

The surface presents a story of its own as well: after navigating through an uneasy time, the former fishermen town, commenced a vigorous tussle against the non-controlled fishing after the damages caused in this pristine location.



And with the sole motivation to preserve an intact ecosystem, this community reformed their roots and completely terminate the fishing industry, transforming the focus completely towards a sustainable tourism resulting on environmental benefits for the reef and economical convenience for the local community.



Today, Cabo Pulmo Natural Park is considered a protected natural area, that is home to reefs estimated to be about 20,000 years old, considered a marine treasure of the Baja peninsula.

Sharks, gigantic rays, humpback whales, sea turtles and ospreys are among the many species returning each year to Cabo Pulmo to breed, feed and live in an unsurpassed submarine shelter.
